**As at 1 January 2018**

- » Grants are available to cover 80% of the eligible medical costs, up to the stated maximum grant.
- » The minimum treatment cost of all claims is \$100.
- » Claims relate to the date of treatment, not the application date of the claim.
- » Claims must be submitted on an approved application form, with treatments itemised and dated.
- » Claims must be submitted within six months of treatment.

This Schedule of **Specified Levels of Grants** should be read in conjunction with the General Information and Conditions applying to the Health Fund.

## 1. Key definitions

|                         |   |
|-------------------------|---|
| <b>Home Nursing</b>     | Following surgery or hospitalisation, home nursing by a Registered Nurse or other qualified person and on referral from a Registered Medical Practitioner.  |
| <b>Minor Procedures</b> | Procedures performed by a Registered Specialist or Medical Practitioner (including GPs), which do not need an Anaesthetic, or to be done in a Theatre. This includes but is not limited to: removal of cysts or skin lesions, eye injections, echocardiograms and electrocardiograms. |
| <b>Specialist</b>       | Any health provider who is a Member or Fellow of an appropriately recognised specialist College and is on the vocational register of the Medical Council of New Zealand or equivalent in the Diocese of Polynesia.  |
| <b>Surgery</b>          | A procedure performed by a specialist in a hospital or day surgical unit. This includes Surgeon's and Anaesthetist's fees, theatre fees, hospital accommodation, prostheses, laparoscopic equipment, post-operative in-hospital physiotherapy, X-rays and ancillary hospital charges. |
| <b>Year</b>             | The period 1 January to 31 December inclusive.  |

## 2. Treatments for which grants are not available

- » Any individual treatment that costs less than \$100
- » General Practitioner consultation fee
- » Prescription charges
- » Services of a Psychologist or Counsellor
- » Physiotherapy
- » Treatments for which the cost is recoverable from ACC, a Health Insurance Policy or other source
- » Treatments from persons other than those registered with the Medical Council of New Zealand or equivalent in the Diocese of Polynesia (e.g. podiatry, homeopathy, chiropractic treatments)
- » Sterilisation or infertility
- » Cosmetic Surgery or services not deemed medically necessary including laser surgery
- » Treatment for alcohol or substance abuse, or for self-inflicted injuries
- » Any experimental procedure

## 3. Eligibility

Retired clergy and clergy widows/ers are eligible to make an application for a grant from the Health Fund.

Retired clergy must meet the following conditions:

- » They are ordained; and
- » They are not engaged in regular paid or stipended work for more than 25 hours per week; and
- » They are either:
  - i. A pensioner of The New Zealand Anglican Church Pension Fund; or
  - ii. Of an age to be eligible to apply for New Zealand Superannuation (for New Zealand residents); or
  - iii. Of an age to be eligible to apply for a benefit from the Fijian National Provident Fund (for persons with the Diocese of Polynesia); and
- » They hold a Bishop's license or permission to officiate, or they held a Bishop's license immediately before retirement.
